

3 SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

The Orienteering World Championships (WOC) and the World Trail Orienteering Championships (WTOC) will be held in Trentino and Veneto. The highlands of Folgaria, Lavarone, Luserna in Trentino and Asiago 7 Comuni in Veneto are areas with wonderful landscapes and natural reserves.

A responsible use of natural resources and protection of the ecosystem is a prerequisite for sustainable development.

The organizing committee is committed to use environmental resources in a sustainable way. So we will adopt responsible organizational procedures in order to protect and preserve our forests.

Orienteering is by definition a "sport of the woods". Some of the venues are in the forests in Gallio (loc. Campomulo) and Lavarone, and they are PEFC certified. The sport and sustainability have once again found a reason to proceed on a common path: promoting a greater environmental responsibility and a proper land management.

We are aware of the crucial contribution that a sport like orienteering can lead in communicating the important values of sustainability. So we will also use this opportunity to provide you with complete information on the sustainability of orienteering as the process of sustainable forest management and wood. Specifically, we will make sure to implement the following responsible measures addressed to the organizers, athletes and any other participants.

GUIDELINES FOR THE ORGANIZERS

The conservation project consists of a series of guidelines addressed to all the organizers. These are the guidelines that should be respected in both national and international events:

- Protection of the natural environment along the routes;
- Waste reduction in dining options;
- Waste separation;
- Use of environment-friendly materials;
- Use of sustainable means of transport;
- Eco-friendly prizes.

INFORMATION FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

The project involves the propagation of information about environment-friendly policies for both spectators and athletes. In particular, we will offer:

- Interventions in schools;
- Information panels;
- Vademecum;
- Questionnaires;
- Info point.

FINAL CHECK-OUT

A committee will evaluate the event on the basis of the project objectives to be achieved in the environmental field, measurable and verifiable in progress and at the end of the manifestations of the same. Our goal is to minimize the impact of the event on the environment: to offset emissions of CO2 which will be produced during the various stages of organization and the running of the event.

At the end of the events a special report will be published.

RUBBISH / TRASH

An event of the magnitude of WOC 2014 generates a great amount of waste.

We have arranged for a system of recycling and collection of rubbish at all the venues. We ask you to use the numerous waste bins that are on site. We are planning to recycle them in coordination with the local communities that host our events.

Plastic, glass, compostable trash and burnable rubbish will be optimally recycled. You will help us making WOC 2014 a 'clean' event by respecting the rules of waste separation.

We have arranged for a sufficient number of toilets close to the starts in the forest and in the finish areas. Please use the toilets instead of the forest.

Please leave your cups and wrappers at the refreshment stations.

7 MEDICAL CARE

There is a fixed first-aid medical post in each competition area.

In the race area there are teams on foot with emergency vehicles located throughout the area.

If a competitor is injured in the terrain, the situation and the location of the patient must be notified to the nearest control point person / finish line.

The rescue and evacuation of the injured are organized by the medical staff of the Organization or by the Department of Medical Emergency - SUEM 118.

The staff Qualified Health is identifiable by uniform color "RED".

Other staff for emergencies is identified by the uniform color "YELLOW / BLUE"

The number of National Health Emergency is 118.

Security Emergency: 112

Accident / illness that occur outside of the competitive arenas are treated on the NHS Public.

The contact numbers and addresses of general practitioners available round the clock can be asked from the WOC office.

8 CEREMONY AND BANQUET

OPENING CEREMONIES

The ceremony will be held in Asiago on Sunday 6th of July.

Teams will attend the opening ceremony in their official team uniforms.

The gathering of the athletes will be in Via Giuseppe Verdi (next to the event center of the 5 Days of Italy) where an entire parking lot will be reserved for the athletes and officials.

The starting of the ceremony is at 6,00 pm. The parade will be introduced by the Banda and it will start from the gathering point and will cross all the city of Asiago and its main center (500 meters walk).

VIP and Media will have reserved seats.

National flags are brought by the athletes indicated by the their Federation. They will be preceded by a young athlete from the local teams with the name of the country.

When entering the main square of Asiago the flag will be placed next to the stage. The rest of the team will follow the flow and it will be accommodated in the front of the stage.

A welcome speech will be presented by the major of Asiago followed by the speeches as in the IOF protocol.

The ceremony will last approximately 60 minutes.

The medal awarding ceremony of Venice will follow the opening ceremony.

CLOSING CEREMONY AND BANQUET

The Banquet is planned for the last day (Friday 11th of July) and will be held in Lavarone in Cluny's Pub. Opening time is set at 8,00 pm.

Closing Ceremony will be at the same place during Banquet.

16 ANTI-DOPING

Doping is strictly forbidden, and the organizers of WTOC 2014 are dedicated to supporting the antidoping authorities in their work.

Doping controls may be carried out any time during the competition period. As some sites for the doping controls may be a few minutes' drive away, we invite athletes to be prepared at all events to take along some dry clothes to change after their race. Selected athletes will be given instruction to report to the doping control after finishing their race, and will be escorted by a chaperon.

Doping tests will always be carried out in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of testing. The IOF Anti-Doping Code and rules apply as of 1st February 2010.

Athletes selected for the doping tests must bring an official identification document (with photo) to the doping test area. Accreditation cards with photo must be used for this purpose.

The athlete should also bring along the Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if applicable. In general, the OC strongly suggests that the athletes bring along their ID to all the competitions and events.

17 COMPETITION RULES

The competition rules for IOF Trail Orienteering Events shall apply to the World Trail Orienteering Championships 2014. See IOF Competition Rules on the IOF website: http://www.orienteering.org

PERMITTED DEVIATIONS FROM THE RULES

The organisers of World Trail Orienteering Championships 2013 and 2014 have been granted permission to deviate from the following rules in relation to TempO competitions:

- 1. **Deviation from the rule 6.6.** "Each Federation may enter up to a maximum of three competitors of any physical ability for the PreO competition in the Open class, a maximum of three eligible competitors for the PreO competition in the Paralympic class and a maximum of four competitors for the TempO competition."
 - Each Federation may enter up to a maximum of three competitors of any physical ability for the PreO competition in the Open class, a maximum of three eligible competitors for the PreO competition in the Paralympic class and a maximum of three competitors for the TempO competition.
- 2. **Deviation from the rule 6.7.**"In the TempO competition only the 36 best placed competitors from the qualification may participate in the final; if there is just one qualification heat they will be the top 36, if there are two qualification heats the top 18 from each heat qualify for the final etc."
 - In the TempO competition only the **24** best placed competitors from the qualification may participate in the final; **there is just one qualification heat.**
- 3. **Deviation from the rule 16.9** "A TempO qualification course shall consist of at least 4 control stations and 20 timed controls. A TempO final course shall consist of at least 5 control stations and 25 timed controls. There should be at least three timed controls at each control station. A separate, specially prepared map is used for each timed control and the competitor is given the complete ordered set of maps for the control station as a stack with a cover sheet on top."
 - Exceptions are made to this rule in Finland and in Italy. A TempO final course can consist of less control stations and timed controls, because of different way of ranking competitors.
- 4. **Deviation from the rule 25.15** "In the individual World TempO Championship competitions, the competitors are ranked according to their placing in the final course."
 - Competitors who competed in the final course are ranked according to their total accumulated time from both the qualification course and the final course. The other competitors are not ranked."

18 COMPETITION DETAILS

RIRS

All competitors must wear their respective number bibs at all WTOC 2014 competitions. Bibs will be available at TOM: on sunday 6th for TempO, on Thuesday 8th july for PreO. Bibs must be visible in their entirety; they shall not be folded over or cut down.

There will be different bibs for TempO (black), PreO Open (red) and PreO Para (blue). From number 31 and on bibs are assigned random; from number 1 to number 30 they are assigned considering previous WTOC results.

For example the World Champion 2013 in Open class will receive bib n 1 red colour, and so on.

MAPS

Competition maps are available for teams after each competition in the Arena WTOC Office and later in the Event Centre WTOC Office.

All competition maps are in scale 1:4.000 contour 2,5m.


All WTOC competition maps are spot colour offset printed (PMS colours) on 115 g/m2 paper + plastic bag.

CLASSES AND ENTRY REGULATIONS WTOC

In the individual PreO competitions there is one Open class and one Paralympic class. Competitors may only be entered for one class. In the TempO competition there is a single Open class. All competitors, regardless of sex, age or physical ability/disability are eligible to be entered for a World Championship Open class competition.




The SPORTIdent punching system will be used to take the overall competition times. At the control stations, the competitors use the traditional manual punching system.

21 TERRAIN DESCRIPTIONS

MILLEGROBBE-LUSERNA

First PreO competition will be held in Millegrobbe and Luserna area with stretches of alpine, pine and spruce is a mix of areas with good visibility, and areas where vegetation is more dense. Fortifications from the World War are part of the landscape.

CAMPOMULO

The second PreO competition is organized in Campomulo, which is part of Asiago karstik highland, in the altitude of 1500-1700 meters above sea level. The landscape is characterized by many terraces divided by steeper areas. Vegetation varies from alpine pastures to open forest, mainly coniferous, and the ground surface is very rocky. Trenches from World War are very common in this area. The network of paths, tracks and roads is not very dense. Cross country ski tracks exist in parts of the area.

ALBERÉ DI TENNA

The famous pine forest of Alberè di Tenna will host the TempO qualification on the hill. The Tenna hill is situated exactly in the middle between Caldonazzo lake and Levico Lake. The terrain is an open forest with very good visibility and trenches from the World War.

LEVICO

TempO final will be in the biggest historical park in Trentino region. Garden pertaining to the House of Hapsburg was created in the 1898 by Georg Zielhl. Many centuries old giant sequoia, copper-beech and Himalayan cedar still grow in the garden.







Course consists of three different parts and three different maps. So during the course there will be two stop times and two map changes.

Between first finish and second start there is only a walking part. At the second finish there will be a stop for time controls and after them there will be toilets and refreshement before going to the third start.

Distance from Assembly area to Quarantine zone and start is 1.500m with climb of 45m. Estimated time with very slow walking is 30min.

First athlete is called to start from assembly area in Millegrobbe 45min before the first start so around 9:15 We kindly ask everybody to be ready at the Assembly area 45min before their starting time.

Distance from the Finish to Assembly in Malga Millegrobbe 1.500m, no climb. Estimated time with very slow walking is 30min.





First stop is for timed controls and the second stop is for Team time control plus toilet and refreshement.

Timed controls are three in total for both Open and Para.

Open: one control station with 2 tasks before the beginning of the course and one control station with 1 task in the middle of the course.

Para: one control station with 1 task before the beginning of the course and one control station with 2 tasks in the middle of the course.
